



Job Bridge is a European project which aims to improve the recognition and the validation of volunteers' competences in the FU.

Based on the needs of volunteer-based organisations and employers, it aims to provide the most appropriate **methods** and tools to assess volunteers' transversal competences and support their learning paths.

The project will bridge informal, non-formal and formal learning by integrating volunteers' competences (knowledge, skills, attitudes) into a system that employers will value.







## Our objectives:



Better understanding of the skills acquired in volunteering activities by collecting examples of tools and competence frameworks in use in the different partner countries;



Identifying life skills developed in volunteering and how they can be connected to existing frameworks (ECVET, EQF, Europass, ECTS);



Developing a **competence matrix** that is adapted to a volunteering context;



Developing and testing a user-friendly tool for facilitators to assess the competences of their volunteers, build a learning plan and deliver a certificate at the end of the process;



Raising awareness of employers about the skills developed as part of voluntary activities.
